VOTER'S MEETING NOTES:

1) At the Voter's assembly meeting November 15, 2016 a motion was passed to create a Task Force "to investigate re-organizing of church financials, worship times, paid staff etc." The output of this task force would be a non-binding recommendation that would then be presented back to the congregation. As a starting point a survey is being created in order to solicit the opinions and views of all members. If you are interested to be on this task force please speak to Tom Kuhl. A kick-off meeting to discuss the survey and approach will be held Saturday, February 20 at 9:00 am.

2) A request has been made from the LC-C Synod's Commission on Constitutional Matters and Structure (CCMS) for people to "Speak their Piece" as they begin the process to look at restructuring the organization of the synod. You are invited to participate in a survey relating to the organization of the synod which will give this commission information which they can use to base their recommendations. There are two ways to complete this survey: 1) manually fill-in a hardcopy of the survey available at the back of the church or 2) online at the following website:
