Social Ministry and Health Committee: I recommended to Council that no further action be taken as a congregation regarding refugee sponsorship for the following reasons. 1) The motion that came from the floor almost duplicated the motion last year, to form a committee to find out more. 2) There was little change in support after the education opportunities about this issue since last year's voters meeting. 3) Again it was suggested that we have been excluded from raising funds for a Niagara Circuit refugee sponsorship fund. That information is incorrect. No such fund exists. Please contact Rev. Lantz for clarification. 4) No one has stepped forward to lead this process if it were to proceed. For those of you who have wanted to know, Grace is delighted with any monetary donations to assist them in settling the extended family of the family they are helping. Gifts of grocery cards and such would also be most welcome. Please contact the Church office at Grace for directions as how to best do so. Please speak with our congregational Chair or Pastor if you would like to know what Council has decided about this issue. CLWR has an excellent reputation nationally and internationally for using donated funds as directed. They have very low operational costs compared to many charitable organizations and remain a valued service organization of LC-C.

<u>wildfires</u>... Please keep the residents, fire fighters, and other emergency workers in your prayers as wildfires continue to burn out of control. We give thanks that there have been no fatalities or serious injuries reported at this time. **Canadian Lutheran World Relief (CLWR)** has set up a **Wildfire Relief Appeal** to assist the rebuilding efforts. A reported 1600 structures have been affected. Emergency funds will be channeled through Lutheran churches in the city. Your help and prayers are appreciated!



Thank you to all who have donated to our Fort McMurray wildfire response. You've generously donated over \$23,000 in just three days. But this is only the beginning. There will be a long recovery ahead for the people of Fort McMurray and we hope you will give your support to the **Lutheran response** to this tragedy. CLWR and the Lutheran churches will be there for the long-term.

Matching donations:

We're glad to announce that <u>FaithLife Financial</u> is responding with a \$10,000 commitment in Special Matching Grants to support fundraising efforts through FaithLife Financial's Chapters across the country.

FaithLife Financial is making \$250 Special Matching Grants available to 40 Chapters, and the funds raised through the grant will be distributed through CLWR.

The Canadian government is matching donations given to the Canadian Red Cross.

Additional gifts:

The Evangelical Lutheran Church in Canada (ELCIC) will give \$5,000 from their Disaster Fund and CLWR will give \$10,000 from our Emergency Fund Reserves. These donations are in addition to the \$23,000 we've received so far.

CLWR's response to the wildfires:

All donations will go to our relief response. We are actively working with the ELCIC Synod of Alberta and the Territories and the Lutheran Church-Canada Alberta British Columbia District to find the best way to help their congregations and the larger community.

Both churches have congregations in Fort McMurray (Christ Lutheran Church and Trinity Lutheran Church, respectively).

Congregation members have reported that they are safe, but there is no definite word yet on the church buildings (Trinity Lutheran has a church; Christ Lutheran met in a school).

With your generous donations, we expect to provide urgent relief items like food and clothing in the short-term.

CLWR is experienced in supporting trauma counselling, and we can see that this may become our focus in the long-term.

We will know more in the coming days, as the situation evolves in Fort McMurray and the surrounding area.

If you have not given, please consider <u>a donation</u> to the Lutheran response to this disaster. The people of Fort McMurray and the surrounding areas will be recovering for years to come, and they need your support. CLWR and the Lutheran churches will be there for the long-term.


