In search of buttons for **mask mate ear savers** which are crocheted, knitted or sewn. The mask goes over the buttons, instead of the ears. Each mask mate needs 2 buttons. Button Style: FLAT Backed only Button Size: can use up to 1 ¼" but no smaller than ¾".

"As a former RN in the operating room, when I stood for 7 or 8 hours during surgeries, my ears took a real beating from those masks. Our front line workers have

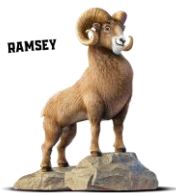


