

GREAT HOPE!

(---by Pastor John Makey on his visit with Kareem, Hamida, Ameer, and little Asser)



Those were the words of Kareem during my recent visit to Athens, Greece to meet with Kareem, Hamida, Ameer, and little Asser. He has great hope because of you willing to reach out and sponsor him and his family to come to safety in Canada. I remember in August of last year when I told Kareem that we would try to sponsor his family, Hamida was given great hope. We here in Canada have no idea of what refugees experience on a day to day basis. They don't know from day to day where they might be sent, or what will happen to them and their families. Kareem has been blessed with some work to have a little extra money to provide for his family over and above the monthly allowance which was reduced some time ago. When I returned home I contacted Canadian Lutheran World Relief to see if they had heard anything from the Immigration Ministry, but they have not been notified of any progress in the sponsorship application. They gave me a website to check the status of the sponsorship application. I used the file number Kareem was given and it showed basically it was on hold. The Afghan situation has complicated things for the processing of immigrates as they will need to be processed first. We must not lose hope! We must pray and continue to encourage one another and Kareem and his family. We have donations of \$16,163.48 to date, this gives us hope that we will be able to accomplish our goal of \$25,000. I plan to put together a power point presentation over the next few weeks, the biggest

difference is to see is little Asser growing from a 4 month old baby into a 22 month old toddler. It was a great blessing to go to Greece and visit our family there, and to play with the boys, and receive the wonderful middle-east hospitality of Kareem and Hamida. I will attempt to tell you more about this in the near future. In the meantime, please continue to pray. We know prayer changes things. Pray first that Kareem and his family remain safe in Athens as they await a date for their immigration interview. Pray that we can all be patient and know it is all in our Lord's hands. Pray that the Lord move the government to move on this application. Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, I cannot express enough the thankfulness of Kareem and Hamida for your work of love to reach out and bring them to Canada. Your work of love is because of God first loving you as St. John puts it so well in his first letter. We love because God first loved us. How beautiful Christian love is! How powerful God's love is. All praise and thanks to God for the love He has shown and given us in Jesus Christ, our Lord and Saviour. Because of Jesus we have great hope. Jesus loves us this we know because the Bible tells us so. Love in Christ, Pastor John, 289-407-7662.

Furthermore, the former priests were many in number, because they were prevented by death from continuing in office; but he holds his priesthood permanently, because he continues for ever. The Holy Gospel: St. Mark 10:46-52

The Holy Gospel, according to St. Mark, the 10th chapter:

Glory to You, O Lord.

They came to Jericho. As Jesus and his disciples and a large crowd were leaving Jericho, Bartimaeus son of Timaeus, a blind beggar, was sitting by the roadside. When he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to shout out and say, 'Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!' Many sternly ordered him to be quiet, but he cried out even more loudly, 'Son of David, have mercy on me!' Jesus stood still and said, 'Call him here.' And they called the blind man, saying to him, 'Take heart; get up, he is calling you. So throwing off his cloak, he sprang up and came to Jesus. Then Jesus said to him, 'What do you want me to do for you?' The blind man said to him, 'My teacher, let me see again.' Jesus said to him, 'Go; your faith has made you well.' Immediately he regained his sight and followed him on the way. This is the Gospel of the Lord.







THE WORDS OF INSTITUTION:








With God as our Friend, with His Spirit and Word,
