THE WORD

The Old Testament: Proverbs 8: 1-4, 22-31

Does not wisdom call, and does not understanding raise her voice? On the heights, beside the way, at the crossroads she takes her stand; beside the gates in front of the town, at the entrance of the portals she cries out: 'To you, O people, I call and my cry is to all that live. The Lord created me at the beginning of his work, the first of his acts of long ago. Ages ago I was set up, at the first, before the beginning of the earth. When there were no depths I was brought forth, when there were no springs abounding with water. Before the mountains had been shaped before the hills, I was brought forth— when he had not yet made earth and fields, or the world's first bits of soil. When he established the heavens, I was there, when he drew a circle on the face of the deep, when he made firm the skies above, when he established the fountains of the deep, when he assigned to the sea its limit, so that the waters might not transgress his command, when he marked out the foundations of the earth, then I was beside him, like a master worker; and I was daily his delight, rejoicing before him always, rejoicing in his inhabited world and delighting in the human race. This is the Word of the Lord.

The New Testament Reading: Acts of the Apostles 2: 14a, 22-36

But Peter, standing with the eleven, raised his voice and addressed them: 'People of Judea and all who live in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and listen to what I say.

'You that are Israelites, listen to what I have to say: Jesus of Nazareth, a man attested to you by God with deeds of power, wonders, and signs that God did through him among you, as you yourselves know— this man, handed over to you according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of those outside the law. But God raised him up, having freed him from death, because it was impossible for him to be held in its power. For David says concerning him, "I saw the Lord always before me, for he is at my right hand so that I will not be shaken; therefore my heart was glad, and my tongue rejoiced; moreover, my flesh will live in hope. For you will not abandon my soul to Hades, or let your Holy One experience corruption. You have made known to me the ways of life; you will make me full of gladness with your presence." 'Fellow Israelites, I may say to you confidently of our ancestor David that he both died and was buried, and his tomb is with us to this day.

Since he was a prophet, he knew that God had sworn with an oath to him that he would put one of his descendants on his throne. Foreseeing this, David spoke of the resurrection of the Messiah, saying, "He was not abandoned to Hades, nor did his flesh experience corruption." This Jesus God raised up, and of that all of us are witnesses. Being therefore exalted at the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, he has poured out this that you both see and hear. For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he himself says, "The Lord said to my Lord, 'Sit at my right

hand, until I make your enemies your footstool.' "Therefore let the entire house of Israel know with certainty that God has made him both Lord and Messiah, this Jesus whom you crucified.' This is the Word of the Lord.


Lord, in your mercy: hear our prayer.





But with You there is forgiveness; therefore You are feared.



The New Testament Reading:


Acts of the Apostles 2: 14a, 22-36

But Peter, standing with the eleven, raised his voice and addressed them: 'People of Judea and all who live in Jerusalem, let this be known to you, and listen to what I say.





Holy Trinity Sunday (series C)

Scripture: Proverbs 8: 1-4, 21-30

Sermon: "God's Not So Common Sense"

June 12, 2022

Today's Trinity message is from OT Proverbs, chapter 8: "Does not wisdom call, and does not understanding raise her voice? ... The Lord God wove wisdom from the very beginning of his work, the first of his acts of long ago. Ages ago she was set up ... working beside God, like a master craftsman."

In the name of the Father, Son + and Holy Spirit. Amen.

There's an old, old saying which reads "the smartest man is the one who knows what he's dumb at..." There's a lot to be said for not only knowing yourself, but the wisdom to know limitations of abilities. What we can handle and what we can't.

Wisdom is a lot like electricity in your home. Can't really see how it works but you know its there when the lights go on. You knows its there, it works, its reliable.

Wisdom is like common sense. Simply knowing right from wrong, what works well, what doesn't and the memory to recall that. Appreciating both order and an ability to adapt. Learning carefully from past experiences.

Taking the time to think and reflect, what you would do differently given the opportunity. Self-editing words before they come out of our mouths or get texted to a friend. Wisdom.

God speaks of wisdom through Solomon's Proverbs. Solomon is King David's son who also ruled as one of Israel's best loved Kings. He wrote Proverbs as a collection of wise teachings for living faithfully to God while waiting for the ultimate hope of the Saviour, Jesus Christ, Who alone would bring in wise rule with lasting peace.

It's also great speaking of Proverbs on the Festival of the Holy Trinity. The day we set aside in the church to honour the wisdom of how our God comes to us: the ONE TRUE GOD in the persons of Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

Our Father is Spirit without a Body, thus He wove together WISDOM through HIS Spoken Word echoing out from the very beginning of creation. That Word is God's Son, JESUS CHRIST. Who eventually becomes real flesh and blood and bone, walking this earth as one of us. HUMAN from the

heritage of Mary, GOD from the seed of the Holy Spirit. Perfect God and Perfect Man. And the Holy Spirit is also without a body and yet is sent to the earth at times in the form of WIND, a DOVE, SMOKE, and tongues of FIRE.

Who God is and how He relates to us began long before earth came to be. God's ability is ancient and beyond our human abilities. Which makes His ability to care for us in our times of need that much richer. Even this very truth comes to us as WISDOM. Proverbs calls wisdom "she", sharing her understanding on the earth about all that's important to our faith and life in God. Wisdom in Proverbs ISN'T GOD but comes from God's working in the world.

Isn't that fascinating!? Our Father created female wisdom. She opens up our minds and works alongside His Word. She is from the beginning before time with God, created by Him, doing His work of teaching and guiding. The original Hebrew understanding is that God wove wisdom from Heavenly fabric to enlighten our messy chaotic world. Whenever God spoke out loud this wisdom circulated around the earth, entering into the ears of His people, creating the living Scriptures we have before us. God the weaver, the artisan, the builder, with wisdom filling in all the blanks!

This wisdom, like the Holy Trinity, is a holy mystery. All that we believe about God in the Scriptures is a mystery. Even the Sacraments of Baptism, forgiveness and Communion are mysteries because we trust that God has promised they're for our good.

We trust that God comes to us as the Father, Son and Holy Spirit with the water of Baptism. We trust that this washing is so unique from other waters because these waters provide forgiveness of sins, the indwelling of our God and welcome us into His family.

We trust that whenever we are forgiven anything we've done wrong is never held against us because God Himself has declared us free and clear.

We trust that God's Word of Scripture is enough to feed our faith and trust and hope in Him.

We trust that when the Words from Jesus' Last Supper are spoken over bread and wine on the altar they house the Body and Blood of Christ in them. We eat and drink the blessed glory of Jesus' life and death, and we show Jesus to the world whenever we eat His Meal.

We trust this mystery to be true and sure. God has promised. This is His Wisdom. While wisdom has become interwoven into the creation, like God's will. Yet, even with God's 10 commands,

this enlightenment isn't enough to fully enlighten our hearts and minds. It still can't drive out the opposite of wisdom—which is sinful human foolishness.

Foolishness fools us into thinking we can do what we want when we want as if we have no limitations. That we can live without God's help. We become foolish by neglecting wisdom because wisdom involves thoughtfulness, time, compassion, listening...all skills which take work & release our need to control. Foolishness seeks its own way to save the self at all cost. Foolishness takes, finds giving costly & stressful & burdensome. We tell ourselves we give what we can, but we don't. Foolishness becomes fearful and selfish. Fools trust in other things than God.

Wisdom from God's Word creates & renovates & rebuilds where human sinful foolishness tears down & wrecks & demolishes.

So God sets His wisdom upon His Son, the promised Christ, Jesus our Lord. Born as God in a human body. Filled with power from on high as the 2nd person of the Trinity, the living Word, walking, eating, talking, teaching. Set with the spirit of wisdom & understanding & council & might.

Wisdom as the Great Craftsman surrounds the Carpenter's Son. Wisdom is overjoyed as Christ makes the lame run and breaks all the chains from every known captive. Jesus invites all He meets to enter into His unique forgiving freedom to go & be foolish no more. In this Wisdom delights.

But the Son got rejected. Human foolishness turned into outrage & anger which chose not to see truth & beauty coming from the Saviour's face. The authorities under God's own ancient wise plan to save the world led Jesus to death.

Jesus dying on a cross as an outcast criminal is God's foolishness, which is wiser than human wisdom. The great mystery is solved. Jesus' dies and releases the entire world from its entangled foolish ways. Jesus dies and lets every human being off the hook from having to suffer death for their sins. Heaven is open to all and God's wisdom is shared with all believers. Jesus' own empty grave proves fools don't have the last word.

All this is from our God, beyond us and our human limits. Beyond our plans and our values. Which is why God created His wisdom - so that we could know His loving heart by knowing Jesus, whom we know deeply by our faith.

Our generous Father loves, gives, creates, blesses, teaches, a truly perfect model for all people but especially men and very good to hear on fathers today. Traits of our Heavenly Father are patience (which is a willingness to put up long with some things in life), compassion, wisdom, courage,

sacrifice...all great traits He gives to all through His Son. We can be confident in hope and strong in our faith, without fear of being vulnerable, without fear of being joyful or peaceful or wise. Wisdom says we laugh when things are funny and cry when life is sad.

Like common sense, we may see wisdom in short supply today in our world. Common sense can be taught. But it involves learning and growing and seeing mistakes as avenues for a new start. Thinking before acting. The very idea that we need CAUTION: HOT COFFEE written boldly on McDonald's coffee cups shows just how much common sense IS missing!

But God has set His wisdom and His very own self within us. Even when we see churches or Christians act foolish or hasty or harmful our witness of Christ in our lives will show faithful wisdom. Our pushback against these trends will be our confident yet gentle trust in Jesus Who has the power to make all things new.

He's made us new. We're woven together as one by faith. God still weaves our whole lives on a knitted path with trials to overcome and joys to celebrate. Never alone. But with Christ and His Spirit moving our feet into God's way.

Wisdom in Christ helps guide our words, inspire our imaginations and fill our witness so that all other will lay aside foolish ways and be wise in God's way. The way of peace, the way of love, the way of peace, the wise way.
