





SCRIPTURE

Old Testament: Genesis 12:1-4

Now the Lord said to Abram, 'Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you. I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you, and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and the one who curses you I will curse; and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.' So Abram went, as the Lord had told him; and Lot went with him. Abram was seventy-five years old when he departed from Haran.

This is the Word of the Lord. Thanks be to God.

Epistle: Romans 4:1-5, 13-17

[St. Paul writes]: What then are we to say was gained by Abraham, our ancestor according to the flesh? For if Abraham was justified by works, he has something to boast about, but not before God. For what does the scripture say? 'Abraham believed God, and it was reckoned to him as righteousness.' Now to one who works, wages are not reckoned as a gift but as something due. But to one who without works trusts him who justifies the ungodly, such faith is reckoned as righteousness... For the promise that he would inherit the world did not come to Abraham or to his descendants through the law but through the righteousness of faith. If it is the adherents of the law who are to be the heirs, faith is null and the promise is void. For the law brings wrath; but where there is no law, neither is there violation For this reason it depends on faith, in order that the promise may rest on grace and be guaranteed to all his descendants, not only to the adherents of the law but also to those who share the faith of Abraham (for he is the father of all of us, as it is written, 'I have made you the father of many nations')—in the presence of the God in whom he believed, who gives life to the dead and calls into existence the things that do not exist.

This is the Word of the Lord. Thanks be to God.

Spoken Gospel Verse: St. Mark 10:45

The Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many.

Holy Gospel: St. John 3: 1-17

The Holy Gospel, according to St. John, the 3rd chapter: **Glory to You, O Lord.**

Now there was a Pharisee named Nicodemus, a leader of the Jews. He came to Jesus by night and said to him, 'Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher who has come from God; for no one can do these signs that you do apart from the presence of God.' Jesus answered him, 'Very truly, I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God without being born from above.' Nicodemus said to him, 'How can anyone be born after having grown old? Can one enter a second time into the mother's womb and be born?' Jesus answered, 'Very truly, I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God without being born of water and Spirit. What is born of the flesh is flesh, and what is born of the Spirit is spirit. Do not be astonished that I said to you, "You must be born from above." The wind blows where it chooses, and you hear the sound of it, but you do not know where it comes from or where it goes. So it is with everyone who is born of the Spirit.' Nicodemus said to him, 'How can these things be?' Jesus answered him, 'Are you a teacher of Israel, and yet you do not understand these things? 'Very truly, I tell you, we speak of what we know and testify to what we have seen; yet you do not receive our testimony. If I have told you about earthly things and you do not believe, how can you believe if I tell you about heavenly things? No one has ascended into heaven except the one who descended from heaven, the Son of Man. And just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that whoever believes in him may have eternal life. 'For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life. 'Indeed, God did not send the Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.

This is the Gospel of the Lord: Praise to You, O Christ!

REV. TODD HOEFFS LENT 2 John 3:16-18 ALL MEANS ALL March 5, 2023

For God so loved the whole world that He gave His only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life. Indeed, God did not send the Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. [from John 3]

I have a wooden chip carving name plate on my desk.

An aged member of my Edmonton parish made it for me.

One side reads REV. TODD HOEFFS; the other side reads:

GOD IS LOVE: HE DIED FOR ALL.

The carver told me this way, you will see the message and always have something to share with whomever walks through your door.

A message he drew from John 3:16, the Gospel reading today. God so loved the whole world.

Koσμος (cosmos) is the Greek word John chooses for "world". It's creation in its entirety.

Universe, galaxies, stars, planets, everything – earth.

The ground, the plants, mountains, water--

everything is of value and in need of redeeming.

Because everything is negatively affected by human sin. That world was pretty large in John's day—Which included Roman soldiers, pagans, Pharisees, people who went to the temple regularly and those who weren't allowed in the temple, lepers and other "unclean" folk – anyone regarded as public sinners to be avoided—Today our world is even bigger and we know more and more about it and the outer limits in space. Today we look on our phones and tablets viewing news like a window into the outside world. Everyone is included in the world God so loved.

All means all. When you learn how to sit at the table with the Judas you know,

You'll appreciate and understand the love of Jesus. God loves the world so much that He gave everything. That is how we are motivated to give.

It's God's world. We are called to love it. As Nicodemus learns at night with Jesus.

Obviously he's curious. Nicodemus shares how he "knows He's are a teacher from God,

for none can do as he can do apart from God's Presence." Nicodemus is a leader among the Jews.

In public, Nicodemus's loyalties are clearly devoted to the religious establishment.

But in private, he has doubts. Jesus is more than a good teacher of the God's Law,

Jesus IS the Living walking talking WORD, anointed with the Spirit. HE and the Father are One.

Nicodemus wants this kind of relationship. Jesus is asking Nicodemus to be born in a new way, to be born from above, to bear His divine logic in a world so not divine.

Jesus is asking Nicodemus to be on the ground floor of something new.

To turn away from what has been done before, to turn away from the rules and logic that have ordered his life up to this point, to step out into the world in a new way.

A new view. A new love. A new vision and pattern for living and seeing the world.

To be born is to be absolutely dependent. It's to begin to learn life and language from scratch.

To be born is to be profoundly naïve to the world. Born again is a common translation foe this passage. It's really BORN FROM ABOVE. Born in a new way which only God can orchestrate.

By Word and water and Spirit. This recalls Jesus' own emergence from the waters of the Jordan.

It recalls Israel's own emergence from slavery into liberation through the waters of a parted Red sea.



To forge an identity apart from the ritual and rule which has shaped them and so re-imagine their communities and their very lives as God does. Born from above means we are living with a new pattern of living, a new way of approaching people and faith and heaven, a radically altered perception. As with birth we breath in oxygen to our lungs, Born from above involves breathing in the Holy Spirit, A lifetime of enjoying God's grace and mercy. Nicodemus has inherited a great tradition, for he is a Pharisee; he has tested it in the experience of life; he has conformed to it his habits of conduct, speech, thought and feeling. How can he break away from all this and begin again? It's as hard as returning to his mother's womb and coming out again. Born from above and born of the spirit are unknowns. The Holy Spirit Himself will lead all people into this new way of life. The Spirit is like the wind. He calls all to faith as He wishes. He brings you not only to see the Kingdom of God, but you get to *enter* it. You're not a silent passenger. Or a mere dreamlike

Deepening our trust in God. Increasing our willingness to follow. Walking more and more to the Light so that our wayward sinful stepping diminishes. And LOVE is the reason behind it all.

philosophy. Entry into the Kingdom of God is by Baptism and faith in Jesus.

God so loved the world. Agape love. A sacrificial love. A giving love with no strings attached. NO pre-requisites. No exams. No cost to you. Only cost to God. High cost. The price of Jesus' life. Yet, why love a world prone to wander? Why keep covenant with a people who too often turn their backs – and I'm not just talking about all the sinners out *there*. Why would God continue to love ones such as us? Ones settled in our ways and satisfied – kinda – with going through the motions of our days. Though it's easier to bring to mind people out *there* who don't even seem to be thinking about God or faith, and all the ways we're really not that loveable.

Why would God keep on loving the mess which is us? This isn't the once-upon-a-time love of a distant God, This is a lasting, gruelling, focused, intense love that moved God to send Jesus to die. Jesus' sacrifice on the cross Clears away our sins and the damage they've done to our relationship with God. God loves. We love God. We love others. We love ourselves...? How???? Love is hard. We humans pamper ourselves, baby each other and are terrible enablers. We look to blame people for what's wrong in our lives. We are all too often over-concerned with self at the expense of people around us. We can only love ourselves because God loves us 1st. We can only love those beyond the walls because God loves the whole world. God IS LOVE and we love as deeply as He does. Because we are born from above. We have a new outlook. Our eyes may see a person not deserving of love But our faith has a Spirit created filter over our eyes So that we see our selves And each other As children of God worthy of love. When we love one another,

God dwells deeply within us, and His love becomes complete in us!" When we act in love We no longer have the old negative self Lashing out or judging or condemning – That's not love, We have a new self, born of God, Which sees life as God sees life. Which sees people as fellow brothers and sisters worthy of respect, And honour and value and welcome and love.

By this new way we will only die an earthly death, Body into the grave like Jesus. But we will not perish. We will not be dead forever. We will live forever with God. God has called us to be the Body of Jesus in the world giving witness to this message. While the things we see and feel and experience might put us off, The world is not condemned And we don't need to add any condemnation. Satan is condemned. He is the enemy chained to hell. The KOSMOS is there for us to love in what we say, what we do and how we think. That is how we engage the world, And how we love the world as God loves. It's not fearful, its freeing. It's not a waste, it's a witness.

This is why we collect Cheez Whiz for street people, Why we collect Bear Paw cookies for people in need downtown; This is why we collect clothing for people who need it; This is why we support SOUL ministries for the developmentally challenged. This is why we have Mary Martha missions, This is why we have Precious Moments mother-baby time; This is why we pray, sing, read the Bible, remember our Baptism, Eat the Body and drink the Blood of Jesus,

So God's LOVE becomes our LOVE We can love ourselves as God loves. We can love others as God loves, And that LOVE is felt in the community. All are loved. The whole Kosmos. ALL MEANS ALL.
