

We received an email from the immigration office in Rome on Tuesday, November 14th that **Kareem**, **Hamida**, **Ameer**, and **Asser will arrive at the Toronto Airport on Thursday**, **November 23 at 5:00 P.M**.

Kareem's "BIG HOPE" is becoming reality!

God has answered our prayers over the past 3 years on his time schedule, and as frustrated as we were at times God is always faithful, and we thank Him for his great love.

Ameer celebrated his 6th Birthday on November 15th in Greece with a chocolate cake. He was one very happy little boy. Asser will celebrate his 4th birthday on January 9th here in Canada. These little boys are about to experience a lot of firsts in their lives: a plane ride and airport experience, a car ride which most of our children have experienced since birth, a very different and unique climate, a new language to learn, so many and exciting experiences for them, even milk that come in bags!!!!

Needless to say the committee has sprung into action to make the final preparations for their arrival. The donations of furniture have been placed in the rooms. Members have donated the funds to purchase the new mattresses as required by the government. So many of you have stepped forward to assist in many different ways and have given donations in kind. We are so thankful to everyone. Ivy has continued to make lists and checking them off. Sue and Lorraine have gone out grocery shopping to have some food in the kitchen for Hamida to prepare for her family. I am sure we have forgotten something, but God is so good.

With their final arrival coming so quickly we haven't been able to put food lists in the bulletin. Some people have donated items and some we have purchased. We thank God for giving us the wisdom to rent accommodation for the family starting November 1st. We thank the council of Christ Lutheran for giving us the freedom to go out and obtain rental accommodation not knowing the exact time of their arrival. We cannot thank God enough for leading us through this whole process.

There is still much to do to have the family settled in Canada: appointments at Service Canada, and Service Ontario, a bank account to be set up for them, bus passes for the family to use the bus system here in St. Catharines, showing them where best to shop to get the best value, language tests to be arranged for Kareem and Hamida, language training for them, having Ameer enrolled in school, and many other things. We will need your continued financial donations so that we can fulfill our promise to the government to look after this family financially over the next year. And of course we need to continue to hold and keep Kareem, Hamida, Ameer, and Asser in prayer.



I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the Lord,


and You forgave the iniquity of my sin.


[Brief silence for prayerful thoughts for self-awareness.]

SERVICE OF THE WORD

The Old Testament: Zephaniah 1: 7, 12-18

Be silent before the Lord GOD! For the day of the LORD is near; the LORD has prepared a sacrifice and consecrated his guests... At that time I will search Jerusalem with lamps, and I will punish the men who are complacent, those who say in their hearts, 'The LORD will not do good, nor will he do ill.' Their goods shall be plundered, and their houses laid waste. Though they build houses, they shall not inhabit them; though they plant vineyards, they shall not drink wine from them." The great day of the LORD is near, near and hastening fast; the sound of the day of the LORD is bitter; the mighty man cries aloud there. A day of wrath is that day, a day of distress and anguish, a day of ruin and devastation, a day of darkness and gloom, a day of clouds and thick darkness, a day of trumpet blast and battle cry against the fortified cities and against the lofty battlements. I will bring distress on mankind, so that they shall walk like the blind, because they have sinned against the LORD; their blood shall be poured out like dust, and their flesh like dung. Neither their silver nor their gold shall be able to deliver them on the day of the wrath of the LORD. In the fire of his jealousy, all the earth shall be consumed; for a full and sudden end he will make of all the inhabitants of the earth.

The Epistle: 1 Thessalonians 5: 1-11

[St. Paul writes:] Now concerning the times and the seasons, brothers and sisters, you have no need to have anything written to you. For you yourselves are fully aware that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night. While people are saying, "There is peace and security," then sudden destruction will come upon them as labor pains come upon a pregnant woman, and they will not escape. But you are not in darkness, brothers, for that day to surprise you like a thief. For you are all children of light, children of the day. We are not of the night or of the darkness. So then let us not sleep, as others do, but let us keep awake and be sober. For those who sleep, sleep at night, and those who get drunk, are drunk at night. But since we belong to the day, let us be sober, having put on the breastplate of faith and love, and for a helmet the hope of salvation. For God has not destined us for wrath, but to obtain salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ, who died for us so that whether we are awake or asleep we might live with him. Therefore encourage one another and build one another up, just as you are doing. This is the Word of the Lord. **Thanks be to God.**



The Holy Gospel: St. Matthew 25: 14-30

The Holy Gospel, according to St. Matthew, the 25th chapter:




[Jesus says:] "For it will be like a man going on a journey, who called his servants and entrusted to them his property. To one he gave five talents, to another two, to another one, to each according to his ability. Then he went away. He who had received the five talents went at once and traded with them, and he made five talents more. So also he who had the two talents made two talents more. But he who had received the one talent went and dug in the ground and hid his master's money. Now after a long time the master of those servants came and settled accounts with them. And he who had received the five talents came forward, bringing five talents more, saying, 'Master, you delivered to me five talents; here I have made five talents more.' His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a little; I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master.' And he also who had the two talents came forward, saying, 'Master, you delivered to me two talents; here I have made two talents more.' His master said to him, 'Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a little; I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master.' He also who had received the one talent came forward, saying, 'Master, I knew you to be a hard man, reaping where you did not sow, and gathering where you scattered no seed, so I was afraid, and I went and hid your talent in the ground. Here you have what is yours.' But his master answered him, 'You wicked and slothful servant! You knew that I reap where I have not sown and gather where I scattered no seed? Then you ought to have invested my money with the bankers, and at my coming I should have received what was my own with interest. So take the talent from him and give it to him who has the ten talents. For to everyone who has will more be given, and he will have an abundance. But from the one who has not, even what he has will be taken away. And cast the worthless servant into the outer darkness. In that place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.'This is the Gospel of the Lord.






