SCRIPTURAL COMMAND

Our Lord Jesus Christ says: All authority in Heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to keep everything I have entrusted to you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.

ADDRESS

Scripture teaches that we are born sinful and unclean, but that our heavenly Father washes us clean in the waters of baptism. We are re-born as His children as the Holy Spirit renews us and gives us eternal life. Through baptism He graciously forgives us our sins and unites us with our Lord Jesus Christ, so that we share in His death and resurrection.

PRESENTATION Who brings this child for holy baptism? *We do*. How is this child named? (*Name is spoken*)

ADMONITION

Since you as parents and sponsors have brought (Name) to be baptized, you are responsible for his/her upbringing in the Lutheran Church. Remember him/her in your prayers. Bring him/her to the services in God's House and teach him/her the Lord's Prayer, the Creed and the Ten Commandments. Remind him/her of her baptism, set him/her a good example, and provide for his/her instruction in the faith that he/she may join you and all believers around the Lord's Table to feast on Jesus' Body and Blood.

Do you intend to joyfully do this? Yes, I/we do.

MARKING OF THE CROSS

(Name), receive the sign of the holy cross ⁺, upon your forehead and upon your heart, to mark you as one redeemed by Christ the crucified.

GOSPEL PROCLAIMATION

Jesus our Lord says: Let the little children come to me, and do not stop them, because the kingdom of God belongs to such as these. I tell you the truth; unless you receive the Kingdom of God like a little child you shall never enter it.

THE LORD'S PRAYER

Let us ask the blessing of our Lord Jesus Christ on (Name) and pray together the prayer He has taught us:

Our Father, Who art in Heaven, hallowed be Thy name, Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil; for Thine is the Kingdom, and the power and the glory, forever and ever. Amen.

PUBLIC CONFESSION OF THE FAITH

I ask you now to publicly speak your faith in Christ Jesus, reject sin, and confess the faith of the Church, the faith in which we baptize.

Do you renounce the devil and all his works and all his ways?

Yes, I do renounce them.

Do you believe in God, the Father almighty?

Yes, I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Maker of Heaven and earth. Do you believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord?

Yes, I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified,

died, and was buried. He descended into hell; the third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into Heaven, and sits at the right hand of God, the Father almighty, from thence He will come to judge the living and the dead.

Do you believe in the Holy Spirit?

Yes, I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the + life everlasting. Amen.

BAPTISM

(Name), I baptize you in the name of the Father ⁺ and of the Son ⁺ and of the Holy Spirit ⁺. Amen.

May God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, Who has given you the new birth by water and the Spirit and has forgiven you all your sins, strengthen you with His Spirit, so that you receive eternal life. Amen.

PRESENTATION OF CANDLE

Receive this burning light. Live always by the Light of Christ and be ever watchful for His coming that you may meet Him with joy and enter with Him to the Marriage Feast of the Lamb in His Kingdom, which has no end. Let your light so shine before others, that they see your good works and glorify Your Father Who is in Heaven.

PRAYER

Heavenly Father, we join with (Name's) parents in thanking you for giving them this child and for adopting him/her as Your own child in holy baptism. Strengthen him/her faith by Your Holy Spirit, so that his/her sinful self may die each day and he/she may rise to new life with Christ forever. As You have written his/her name in the book of life and have made him/her a member of the body of Your Son, guide him/her, so that, with all Your saints, he/she may one day abide in Your Heavenly Home; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**

PRESENTATION OF BAPTIZED

Through Baptism, God has added this new brother/sister a member of the Priesthood we all share in Christ Jesus, that we may proclaim the praise of God and show forth His creative and redeeming Word to all the world:

We welcome you into the Lord's family. We receive you as fellow members of the body of Christ, children of the same Heavenly Father, and workers with us in His Kingdom.

The peace of the Lord be with you always. And also with you.

"Praise To The Lord, The Almighty"

Praise to the Lord, the Almighty, the King of creation! O my soul, praise him, for he is your health and salvation! Come, all who hear; now to his temple draw near, joining in glad adoration.

SCRIPTURE

Old Testament Isaiah 6:1-8

In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord. He was sitting on a very high throne. His long robe filled the Temple. Burning heavenly creatures stood above him. Each creature had six wings. They used two wings to cover their faces. They used two wings to cover their feet. And they used two wings for flying. Each creature was calling to the others: "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of heaven's armies. His glory fills the whole earth." Their voices caused the frame around the door to shake. The Temple filled with smoke. I said, "Oh, no! I will be destroyed. I am not pure. And I live among people who are not pure. But I have seen the King, the Lord of heaven's armies." On the altar there was a fire. One of the burning heavenly creatures used a pair of tongs to take a hot coal from the fire. Then he flew to me with the hot coal in his hand. The creature touched my mouth with the hot coal. Then he said, "Look. Your guilt is taken away because this hot coal has touched your lips. Your sin is taken away." Then I heard the Lord's voice. He said, "Whom can I send? Who will go for us?" So I said, "Here I am. Send me!" This is the Word of the Lord. **Thanks be to God.**

SCRIPTURE RESPONSES

The New Testament: Acts of the Apostles 2:14, 22-36

Peter, standing with the eleven, raised his voice and addressed them... "You that are Israelites, listen to what I have to say: Jesus of Nazareth, a man attested to you by God with deeds of power, wonders, and signs that God did through him among you, as you yourselves know --- this man, handed over to you according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of those outside the law. But God raised him up, having freed him from death, because it was impossible for him to be held in its power. For David says concerning him, "I saw the Lord always before me, for he is at my right hand so that I will not be shaken; therefore, my heart was glad, and my tongue rejoiced; moreover, my flesh will live in hope. For you will not abandon my soul to Hades or let your Holy One experience corruption. You have made known to me the ways of life; you will make me full of gladness with your presence." 'Fellow Israelites, I may say to you confidently of our ancestor David that he both died and was buried, and his tomb is with us to this day. Since he was a prophet, he knew that God had sworn with an oath to him that he would put one of his descendants on his throne. Foreseeing this, David spoke of the resurrection of the Messiah, saying, "He was not abandoned to Hades, nor did his flesh experience corruption." This Jesus God raised up, and of that all of us are witnesses. Being therefore exalted at the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, he has poured out this that you both see and hear. For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he himself says, "The Lord said to my Lord, 'Sit at my right hand, until I make your enemies your footstool." Therefore let the entire house of Israel know with certainty that God has made him both Lord and Messiah, this Jesus whom you crucified.'

This is the Word of the Lord. Thanks be to God.

Holy Gospel St. John 3:1-17

The Holy Gospel, according to St. John the 3rd chapter: Glory to You, O Lord.

Now there was a Pharisee named Nicodemus, a leader of the Jews. He came to Jesus by night and said to him, 'Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher who has come from God; for no one can do these signs that you do apart from the presence of God.' Jesus answered him, 'Very truly, I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God without being born from above.' Nicodemus said to him, 'How can anyone be born after having grown old? Can one enter a second time into the mother's womb and be born?' Jesus answered, 'Very truly, I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God without being born of water and Spirit. What is born of the flesh is flesh, and what is born of the Spirit is spirit. Do not be astonished that I said to you, "You must be born from above." The wind blows where it chooses, and you hear the sound of it, but you do not know where it comes from or where it goes. So it is with everyone who is born of the Spirit.' Nicodemus said to him, 'How can these things be?' Jesus answered him, 'Are you a teacher of Israel, and yet you do not understand these things? Very truly, I tell you, we speak of what we know and testify to what we have seen; yet you do not receive our testimony. If I have told you about earthly things and you do not believe, how can you believe if I tell you about heavenly things? No one has ascended into heaven except the one who descended from heaven, the Son of Man. And just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that whoever believes in him may have eternal life. 'For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life. Indeed, God did not send the Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.

This is the Gospel of the Lord: Praise to You, O Christ!

ATHANASIAN CREED verses

Whoever desires to be saved must, above all else,

Hold the catholic faith.

And the catholic faith is this:

That we worship one God in Trinity and Trinity in Unity, Neither confusing the persons

Nor dividing the substance.

So the Father is God, the Son is God, and the Holy Spirit is God;

And yet there are not three Gods, but one God.

And in this Trinity none is before or after another; none is greater or less than another.

But the whole three persons are coeternal with each other and coequal.

Therefore, it is the right faith that we believe and confess that our Lord,

Jesus Christ, the Son of God, is at the same time both God and man. He is God, begotten from the substance of the Father before all ages;

And He is man, born from the substance of His mother in this age: Perfect God and perfect man,

Composed of a rational soul and human flesh,

Who suffered for our salvation,

Descended into hell, rose again the third day from the dead,

Ascended into Heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father,

God Almighty, from there He will come to judge the living and the dead. This is the catholic faith.

O Lord, our Lord, how magnificent is your reputation throughout the earth!

You reveal your majesty in the heavens above.

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, they are a new creation.

The old has passed away; behold, the new has come!(2 Cor. 5:17)Let us confess our sins in the presence of God and of one another:

Most Gracious Father, we are by nature sinful and unclean. We have sinned against You in our thoughts, words and deeds. We have committed sins against our neighbour and against You, O Father. Have mercy upon us. In Your compassion forgive us our sins. Those sins which are known to us, and those which are unknown. Grant us Your Holy Spirit that by faith we may be sorry for

our sins, repent of them and serve You in newness of life to the honour and glory of Your Holy Name; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

In the stead and by the command of my Lord Jesus Christ, I forgive you all of your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son + and of the Holy Spirit. **Amen.**

REV. TODD HOEFFS HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY [Pentecost 1] Acts 2:14, 22-33 "Everything Old Is New Again" May 26, 2024 The apple doesn't fall far from the tree. Like Mother, like daughter. What is seen in parents, is often seen in their children. What we see or hear of God, we see or hear of in His Son. Jesus even tells us to call upon Him by saying "Father, Son & Holy Spirit." This is the Trinity and its as old as the 1st few chapters of OT book Genesis. God created the Heavens and the Earth: God = ELOHEEMThe Spirit of God hovers over the waters. RUAH of ELOHEEM. When God creates people, it is the LORD GOD == ELOHEEM YAHWHEY 3 persons, LORD, GOD, & RUAH The Spirit's breath -- making Adam's lungs begin life. Our Triune God is life. Trinity is how we call upon Him in faith. Hear, O Israel, the Lord Your God, is ONE. Father, Son & Spirit ARE ONE – which in Hebrew is unity. God is united. In Him we are One. United. Faith. Scripture. Baptism. Notice today we didn't begin our service with the Trinity invocation? Because Ciara's baptism in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit Began our worship as it signified her gift of faith and forgiveness. Holy Trinity Sunday began as a yearly festival in the 1400s. The creation of the Creeds, whose division around the divinity of Jesus sparked these writings, appeared 300-500 years after Jesus' ascension. Ancient life remained an oral culture. Your words mattered. Saying the most correct and faithful words about God impacted your religious life. The Apostles' Creed [always used in Baptism] is concise and complete. Nicene Creed historically used in connection to Holy Communion Expresses greater detail on how God comes to us in Christ And how the Spirit comes to us from both. The verses from the Athanasian Creed is the last written creed [600] As wishes to clearly express in detail how Jesus is both human and divine. We might think? Well, if its in the Bible, its clear right?

Not really?

It's a shock if we find 2 people who agree on something they experienced. Moreso thousands of different Christians.

So many strange views of God circulated then as now.

[Pour God into Jesus, extract it, infuse it back!!!!]

The Creed help you put into the Word the truths of Scripture easily.

Even if you're a person that doesn't think much of Creeds,

They help us keep believing the same truths of the Bible.

Martin Luther himself encourages us to follow the creeds

As long as they do not go against Scripture.

New apostle Peter makes the Trinity clear in Acts 2,

Which is part of his Pentecost day sermon.

In verses 32 and 33, Peter says:

"This Jesus God raised up, and of that we all are witnesses.

He is exalted at the right hand of God,

and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit,

he has poured out this gift that you are seeing and hearing."

Here we the church's very first Gospel gift of the Holy Trinity.

God is Father. Jesus, the Son, rules with the Father as His rightful heir.

And the Spirit is proclaimed as a separate and yet inter-related identity,

coming from both the Father and from Jesus.

Peter's sermon makes clear that the Father's Kingdom purposes and His saving work culminates in the new world order with Christ in charge, governing in the power of the Spirit.

Peter's audience is primarily familiar with Judaism.

Jesus as the Christ of God was truly unknown then.

They did know about King David,

So Jesus is explained as both David's son and David's Lord.

As David represents ancient Israel,

even more so Jesus represents His reconciled and restored Israel

of both Jews and Gentiles as the world's rightful King.

"You seek Jesus who is crucified"). Fear not, but instead resort to the crucified Son who exhibits the Father's loving forgiveness and bestows the Holy Spirit.

Taking parts of the Psalms and Prophets is an incredible witness

And offers proper context for their faith:

Connecting Jesus with the God of Israel.

The God of creation, the God of history, the living God

finds full and complete revelation in the person, word, and works of Jesus,

"...delivered up according to God's longstanding plan" (<u>Acts 2:23</u>).

Jesus is King. He is in charge.

It is the Gospel, sweet gospel, not legalism nor law which is in the forefront. But don't forget: "You crucified Him."

Ouch. That must sting.

It does.

Truth hurts.

This Jesus, resurrected, ascended, and ever present through the Spirit,

Still and ever always graciously abides as the ever-crucified Lord.

Who died on Cavalry once, for all, saying it is finished.

The work to save us is done.

Up to this point, if you asked anyone within the temple or synagogue how they would experience God, they'd say:

look within yourself

and to make your very best effort to be the best you can

to fulfill various standards of law, some more severe, some less.

Not terribly helpful.

Keeps you busy, trying, play up to God, hoping He doesn't see the decay within. To know the problem is not to solve it.

Baptism in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of sins resolves it.

We need good news, not good advice.

The crucifixion, necessitated by our sins that condemn us,

now resounds as the victory of Christ over sin and death,

capped by the dawning of the new creation in Jesus' resurrection!

Believe. Be baptized.

The Truth heals.

The action here is entirely from God towards us.

This is what sets it apart from every religion and philosophy as the Gospel — good news, as opposed to dutiful religious obligation.

Notice Peter ties forgiveness to getting baptized and repenting.

From the gift comes the life of the grateful receiver.

Repent 1st doesn't work.

You and I can't fix ourselves.

Baptism and repentance go together.

It's the love and the marriage.

The unity with the Holy Communion.

Baptism into the life of God makes sure you have a life-line of faith and grace. The true test of Gospel focused evangelism is this:

Do missionaries feed hungry stomachs first and then teach them of God,

Or make them listen to their words 1st and the then feed as a reward?

Real mission work feeds the body so the heart can wrap itself in the love of Jesus.

People don't care how much you know until they know how much you care. You can't pour water from an empty well.

The Fountain of life must be splashing around inside you 1st.

You can feed people because you gave been fed with the Bread of Heaven. You help once you are helped.

You love because you've been loved 1st

When people encounter us, they encounter the living Lord inside our bodies,

On our lips, in our minds, through our hands and feet.

We receive the Trinity,

People experience the trinity in us.

Jesus and the Father are one.

All they have we have.

As we are ONE in God, we can be ONE for all others.

Unity never means exactness.

Unity doesn't remove the need for diversity.

No two people will ever be exactly the same.

Each of us have gifts, talents, jobs, interests and passions

Which help move along the Body of Christ in the world.

And like a magnet, people will be drawn to the love which radiates from you.

Because, apples don't fall far from the main tree.

We belong to God.

Like Father, like Son.

Like Father, like children.

Amen.
